Tournament Information & Rules for the County Club of Mount Dora

AWARDS:

First Place Team -- \$100.00 / player
Second Place Team -- \$50.00 / player
Third Place Team -- \$25.00 / player
Closest to the Pin on Hole #12 -- \$25.00
Longest Drive on Hole #18 -- \$25.00

Play Format: Four (4) Person Scramble. All Players will hit from the Tee, the best shot is selected and then all 4 players will play from that point. This process of all players shooting from the best selected shot will be repeated until the ultimate completion of respective hole.

For Fairway play, the ball may be moved One Club Length from the original shot selected and will not be positioned any closer to the hole. In all circumstances the ball must remain in the same condition (i.e.. fairway, rough or hazard). On the putting green surface the ball will be played as close as possible from the the position of the selected ball.

- USGA Rules will Govern All Play with the addition of the rules noted above
- The Ball may be lifted, cleaned and placed for any fairway or green shot
- All Water Hazards are played as lateral hazards. A Red Line or Red Stakes shall define the margin of the Hazard. When both are present the Red Line defines the hazard margin
- White Stakes or Post will define Out of Bounds
- The Inside edge of the Curb on Holes #1, #2, #5, #6, #8, & #10 is defined as Out of Bounds
- All ties will be broken by the Men's #1 Handicap Hole and so on
- Please remember to return all Score Cards to the Pro Shop, Signed and Attested at the end of Play.
